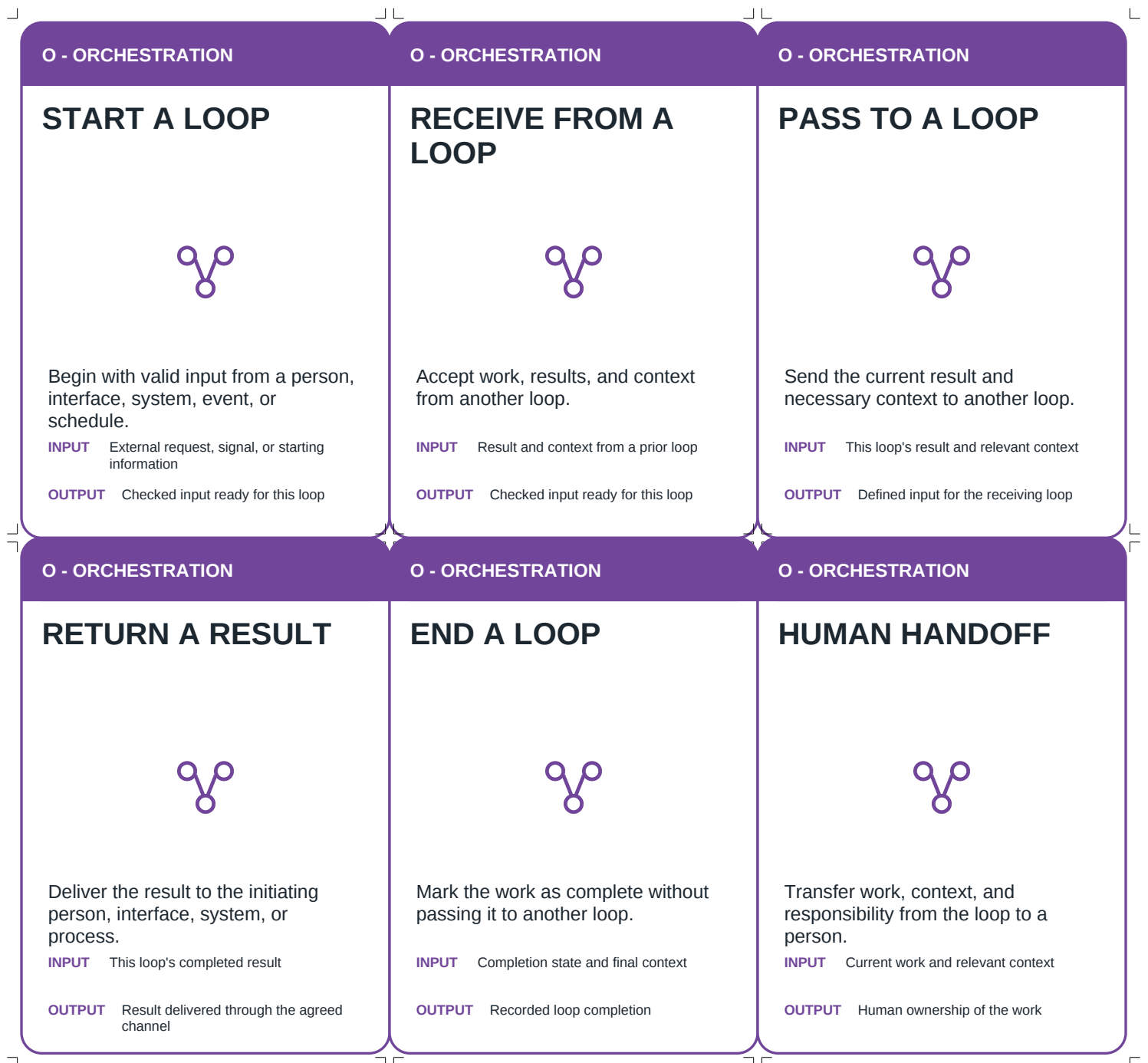




O - ORCHESTRATION**Input**

This loop's result and relevant context

Output

Defined input for the receiving loop

Provides

- Directed connection
- Clearly described handoff

Strategic Question

What becomes possible by passing this work to another loop?

Consider

- ? What context must accompany the handoff?
- ? Where does accountability sit after the handoff?

O - ORCHESTRATION**Input**

Result and context from a prior loop

Output

Checked input ready for this loop

Provides

- Loop-to-loop handoff
- Validated incoming work

Strategic Question

What must this loop receive to do its work successfully?

Consider

- ? Who or what is responsible for providing it?
- ? How will the loop know that it is complete and trustworthy?

O - ORCHESTRATION**Input**

External request, signal, or starting information

Output

Checked input ready for this loop

Provides

- Defined entry point
- Valid starting information

Strategic Question

What organizational need or opportunity justifies starting this work?

Consider

- ? Who or what has authority to initiate it?
- ? What commitment does starting it create?

O - ORCHESTRATION**Input**

Current work and relevant context

Output

Human ownership of the work

Provides

- Ownership transfer
- Human control
- Clear stopping or resumption point

Strategic Question

Where does human judgment create value that automation should not replace?

Consider

- ? Who needs the authority and capability to take over?
- ? What context must be available for an effective handoff?

O - ORCHESTRATION**Input**

Completion state and final context

Output

Recorded loop completion

Provides

- Explicit stopping point
- Final status

Strategic Question

What evidence shows that the work has created enough value to stop?

Consider

- ? Who decides that it is complete?
- ? What should be retained for learning, review, or future work?

O - ORCHESTRATION**Input**

This loop's completed result

Output

Result delivered through the agreed channel

Provides

- Returned result
- Clear completion response

Strategic Question

Who will use this result, and what decision or action should it support?

Consider

- ? What evidence will make the result trustworthy?
- ? How should limitations or uncertainty be communicated?
